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#### WILDRIDGE REMINDERS FOR EVERYONE

#### **LEAF COLLECTION:**

Leaf vacuum collection will be provided from March 1 - Oct. 31, weather permitting. Leaves must be neatly piled at the edge of the road in front of the members lot so as not to impede traffic flow or to impair drainage. Leaves should not be placed in drainage ditches. From Nov. 1 - Feb. 28 bagged leaves in yard waste bags will be collected periodically. During this period of the year, the vacuum is less effective and is not used. No loose leaves should be accumulated/piled up. PLEASE ENSURE THAT ONLY LEAVES ARE IN THE PILES AS OTHER DEBRIS CAN DAMAGE EQUIPMENT.

#### **WOOD CHIPPING:**

Chipping of small tree branches will be provided on a bi-weekly basis (normally during the 2nd & 4th week of each month). Branches must be bundled or neatly stacked at the edge of the road in front of the members lot so as not to impede traffic flow or to impair drainage. Branches should not be placed in drainage ditches.

This service is intended to help member with minor trimming and maintenance of their lots. Branches must not exceed 4 inches in diameter and 5 feet in length. All bundled branches must be stripped and neatly placed at the roadside. The removal of branches exceeding 4 inches in diameter is the responsibility of the individual lot member. This is often accomplished by using a professional tree service to maintain trees and dispose of the cuttings.

#### LOT CONDITION

In accordance with the Wildridge Association covenants, lease-holders are to keep their lots in good, clean and orderly condition. All campers and structures on the lot are to be kept in good repair, clean, painted and maintained. All grass & weeds are to be kept mowed including area between lot and the edge of the road pavement.

Management has been and will continue making contact with members who are in violation of this covenant in an attempt to keep the park looking its best

If you have any lots in your area you feel need to be addressed, please contact the manager.

#### **GUESTS**

Although you may call the gate house at (812)827-9251 to have your guests name put on a list for access to the park, it is always best to arrange to meet them at the gate since the guard may be on rounds when they arrive.

It was recently brought to our attention that members who have their golf cart insurance added to their homeowner policy for their property may not be insured once the golf cart leaves the property. Especially if it is on your policy for a property other than Wildridge. Please check with your agent to make sure you are properly insured.

We make every effort to have a large container here on Memorial Day, July 4th, and Labor Day. This is done to allow members to dispose of unwanted items. #### WHEN DO YOU NEED A PERMIT?

#### **Permit for Improvement**

- 1. A permit is required before any building or construction project is started. To obtain a permit, a documented plan must be submitted by the lease holder and approved by Wildridge representatives. The approved permit must be displayed during the entire period that the project work is being conducted. The project must be within the period that the permit is applicable or a renewal must be approved in writing. Building permits are dated and good for a period of six months.
- No buildings, temporary or permanent, may be constructed or cause to be constructed unless plans and specifications have been approved by the Wildridge Association. Approval is documented using a building permit.
- Contractors performing work for the member shall provide a certificate of liability insurance and must be approved as part of the permit request.
- 4. The permit must be posted before work can begin on the project. Normally, a project can be approved in 30 days or less. All construction is subject to inspection during and after completion.
- 5. Major changes to landscaping require a

- building permit. This includes terracing lots, digging out/leveling lots, building retaining walls or any similar action. This is necessary to help ensure safety is maintained, drainage is not impeded and that neighboring lots are not adversely affected.
- Any time construction equipment will be used (Bobcat, backhoe, dump truck, concrete delivery trucks, etc.), a permit is necessary so that Wildridge representatives can ensure roads and property will not be negatively impacted.

#### **GRAVEL PRERMIT**

You are required to obtain a permit to install gravel to your lot. This applies even if you are adding gravel to an existing graveled area.

Before making any plans and/or contracting or ordering any materials, you must obtain a permit and follow the rules and regulations.

Usually a gravel permit can be obtained within 24 hours of request.
